The GDPR imposes strict protections on the processing and transfer of personal data—defined broadly to include any names, email addresses, or other data that allows any individual to be identified. Yet UK and US discovery rules require large volumes of documents—almost all of them containing such information, to be produced to adverse parties in litigation, and possibly used for court filings, depositions, hearings, trials or other dispute resolution procedures. How can companies, their lawyers and their service providers navigate the resulting conflict between privacy and litigation disclosure requirements?
